ILLNESS NOTIFICATION: Program staff agrees to notify the parent/guardian whenever the child becomes ill, and the parent/guardian agrees to pick child up as soon as possible or arrange to have an adult pick child up.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY RELEASE: The parent/guardian hereby gives authorization, at their own expense, for program staff to obtain immediate medical treatment for the child should any emergency occur when he/she cannot be located immediately. It is also understood that if the child needs to be transported to a Medical Facility, that decision will be made by the rescue personnel who respond to the call. While the child is receiving medical attention, staff will continue to reach the parent/guardian. If unsuccessful, the emergency contact listed will be notified and a staff member will accompany the child until someone arrives.
